

PSA wheelchair drive: Successful Clips&Caps project back!

The PSA, as part of the Union’s centenary undertook random acts of kindness under the banner #DreamProject. The #DreamProject included the Clips&Caps initiative whereby PSA staff and members collect plastic bottle caps and bread tags. These items were recycled by Interwaste in return for wheelchairs.

The *Clips&Caps* initiative was inspired by the PSA’s Dream Ambassador, Miss Mbsa, whose mobility, and passion for life opened many opportunities for her. The PSA was inspired to enable more people with the gift of mobility and has, to date, donated 16 wheelchairs to deserving beneficiaries across the country.

In the wake of the COVID-19 pandemic, the PSA will continue with the *Clips&Caps* initiative in 2022 and encourages members and shop stewards to participate. Plastic bottle caps and bread tags that are collected can be delivered to all PSA Offices for further processing. The project will run from September 2022 to August 2023.

Sta-soft bottle tops, bottled water tops, cooking-oil tops, and mayonnaise bottle tops.

The following indicates the quantities required to secure one wheelchair:

- Bottle Tops: 450 kg = 1 wheelchair
- Bread tags: 50 kg = 1 wheelchair

Shop stewards are requested to assist by submitting collected clips and caps to PSA Provincial Offices.
