Update: COVID-19

The PSA is fully conscious of members' anxiety in the workplace regarding the COVID-19 outbreak. The Western Cape Department of Health issued a recent Circular H27/2020, which speaks to the People Management Response to COVID-19. This document addresses the following issues relating to working arrangements in terms of:

- 1. Leave
- 2. Overtime
- 3. Flexible Working Arrangements
- 4. Gatherings (Meetings, Training, Workshops, Events, etc.)
- 5. Travel
- 6. Occupational Health and Safety:
  - Both the employer and employee are responsible for maintaining a safe and healthy working environment.
  - Staff must wash hands frequently with soap and water for at least 20 seconds
  - · Cover up nose and mouth with tissue or elbow when coughing and sneezing
  - Create physical distance, where possible
  - · Maintain social distance, which includes no physical contact such as hand shaking, etc.
  - Seek medical attention if you have flu or cold symptoms
